## Building Design

- All spaces were renovated and improved for modern technology and building systems. Wireless technology capability is available throughout the building.
- Original 1930's detail was restored and integrated into the renovation.
- Site traffic was greatly improved for traffic control and security.
- The Additions include classroom expansion, new gymnasium and kitchen.
- Reprogrammed spaces include centralized administrative area, new art room, new media center, larger student dining room, and newer/larger science labs. A total of 34 teaching stations are provided.
